Hospital Access Safeguarded

Brive Hospital has selected STid and Vauban Systems to provide access control to its premises and guarantee the protection of its patients. Since November 2016, the Ministry of Health has required all health care facilities to guarantee the security of people, property and data. Access control is managed and video surveillance



provided via Vauban's Visor Access software application, while STid delivers access to premises, offices and treatment rooms with its highly secure Architect access control readers. These offer a level of security in line with recommendations from the French network and information security agency (ANSSI), and are compatible with the future smart cards for health care professionals that will provide access to patient files. The latest building to be equipped is the 'sensitive' maternity ward. The new access control system means premises can be made secure at night, or in exceptional circumstances (aggressive parents, threats to a new mother, risk of kidnapping, etc.).
